CONSENT DECREE FOR RECOVERY OF PAST AND FUTURE RESPONSE COSTS

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I. BACKGROUND

- A. On July 22, 1997, the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") issued a final Record of Decision (the "ROD") (as defined herein) for the Berks Landfill Superfund Site (the "Site"), which is located in Spring Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania. The Remedial Action called for in the ROD includes institutional controls, long-term monitoring, leachate management system, operation and maintenance and cap repair and maintenance at the Site.
- B. On March 31, 1998, EPA issued an Administrative Order for Remedial Design and Remedial Action for the Site, EPA Docket No. III-98-071-DC (the "Order"). Under the terms of the Order,

eighteen respondents were required to implement the remedial action selected in the ROD. The respondents have implemented the remedial action and are implementing operation and maintenance of the remedial action at the Site.

- C. All but one of the respondents to the Order are Settling
 Defendants (as defined herein) to this Consent Decree.
- D. On March 27, 2002, the United States of America, on behalf of the EPA Administrator, filed a complaint pursuant to Section 107 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended ("CERCLA"), 42 U.S.C. § 9607, seeking reimbursement of response costs incurred and to be incurred for response actions taken at or in connection with the release or threatened release of hazardous substances at the Site.
- E. Simultaneous to the filing of that complaint, which was docketed as Civ. No. 02-1681, the United States lodged a consent decree with the defendants named in the complaint. That decree was duly entered by the court and the case was closed on May 30, 2002.
- F. The United States has filed a subsequent complaint under CERCLA Section 107 seeking reimbursement from Settling Defendants of further response costs incurred and to be incurred in

connection with the Site, and the Parties have agreed to a settlement resolving the United States' claims. The terms of this settlement are contained in this Consent Decree.

- G. Settling Defendants do not admit any liability to Plaintiff arising out of the transactions or occurrences alleged in the subsequent complaint.
- H. The United States and Settling Defendants agree, and this Court by entering this Consent Decree finds, that this Consent Decree has been negotiated by the Parties in good faith, that settlement of this matter will avoid prolonged and complicated litigation between the Parties, and that this Consent Decree is fair, reasonable, and in the public interest.

THEREFORE, with the consent of the Parties to this Decree, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

II. JURISDICTION

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1345 and 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607 and 9613(b) and also has personal jurisdiction over Settling Defendants. Settling Defendants consent to and shall not challenge entry of this Consent Decree or this Court's jurisdiction to enter and enforce this Consent Decree.

III. PARTIES BOUND

2. This Consent Decree is binding upon the United States and upon Settling Defendants and their successors and assigns. Any change in ownership or corporate or other legal status, including but not limited to, any transfer of assets or real or personal property, shall in no way alter the status or responsibilities of Settling Defendants under this Consent Decree.

IV. DEFINITIONS

- 3. Unless otherwise expressly provided herein, terms used in this Consent Decree which are defined in CERCLA or in regulations promulgated under CERCLA shall have the meaning assigned to them in CERCLA or in such regulations. Whenever terms listed below are used in this Consent Decree or in any appendix attached hereto, the following definitions shall apply:
- a. "CERCLA" shall mean the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9601 et seq.
- b. "Consent Decree" shall mean this Consent Decree and all appendices attached hereto. In the event of conflict between this Consent Decree and any appendix, the Consent Decree shall control.

- c. "Day" shall mean a calendar day. In computing any period of time under this Consent Decree, where the last day would fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or federal holiday, the period shall run until the close of business of the next working day.
- d. "DOJ" shall mean the United States Department of Justice and any successor departments, agencies or instrumentalities of the United States.
- e. "EPA" shall mean the United States Environmental Protection Agency and any successor departments, agencies or instrumentalities of the United States.
- f. "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund" shall mean the Hazardous Substance Superfund established by the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 9507.
- g. "Future Response Costs" shall mean all costs, including, but not limited to, direct and indirect costs, that the United States incurs in reviewing or developing plans, reports and other items, verifying implementation of the ROD (as defined herein), or otherwise implementing, overseeing, or enforcing Response Actions (as defined herein) at the Site after Effective Date of this Consent Decree as defined in Section XVI herein. Future Response Costs shall also include all Interim Response Costs.

- h. "Interest" shall mean interest at the current rate specified for interest on investments of the Hazardous Substance Superfund established by 26 U.S.C. § 9507, compounded annually on October 1 of each year, in accordance with 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a).
- i. "Interim Response Costs" shall mean (i) all costs, including direct and indirect costs, paid by the United States in connection with the Site between April 29, 2006 and the Effective Date of this Consent Decree as defined in Section XVI herein; (ii) all Interest on those Past Response Costs which Settling Defendants have agreed to reimburse pursuant to Section V, Paragraph 4 of this Consent Decree that has accrued pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a) during the period from April 29, 2006 to the Effective Date of this Consent Decree; and (iii) all costs incurred prior to the Effective Date but paid after the Effective date.
- j. "Municipal Solid Waste" or "MSW" shall mean waste material: (i) generated by a household (including a single or multifamily residence); or (ii) generated by a commercial, industrial or institutional entity, to the extent that the waste material (I) is essentially the same as waste normally generated by a household; (II) is collected and disposed of with other municipal solid waste as part of normal municipal solid

waste collection services; and (III) contains a relative quantity of hazardous substances no greater than the relative quantity of hazardous substances contained in waste material generated by a typical single-family household.

- k. "Paragraph" shall mean a portion of this Consent

 Decree identified by an arabic numeral or an upper or lower case

 letter.
- 1. "Parties" shall mean the United States and the Settling Defendants.
- m. "Past Response Costs" shall mean all costs, including but not limited to direct and indirect costs, that EPA, and/or DOJ on behalf of EPA, has paid in connection with the Site, plus accrued Interest on all such costs, from June 1, 2002 through April 28, 2006. Past Response Costs are identified in the EPA Certified Cost Report attached hereto as Appendix C.
 - n. "Plaintiff" shall mean the United States.
- o. "Record of Decision" or "ROD" shall mean the EPA

 Record of Decision relating to the Site signed on July 22, 1997

 by the Acting Director, Hazardous Waste Management Division, EPA

 Region III, and all attachments thereto.
- p. "Response Action" shall mean all activities as defined by Section 101(25) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(25).

- q. "Section" shall mean a portion of this Consent Decree identified by a roman numeral.
- r. "Settling Defendants" shall mean those parties identified in Appendix A.
- s. "Site" shall mean the Berks Landfill Superfund Site which is located in Spring Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and which is approximately 2.3 miles southwest of the Borough of Sinking Spring and approximately 7 miles southwest of the City of Reading. The Site consists of two closed municipal refuse landfills and associated features located south of Wheatfield Road, the areal extent of contamination which includes the groundwater plume and property necessary to implement the ROD. The Site is depicted more particularly on the map attached hereto as Appendix B.
- t. "United States" shall mean the United States of America, including it departments, agencies and instrumentalities.

V. PAYMENT OF RESPONSE COSTS

- 4. Payment of Past Response Costs to the EPA Hazardous
 Substance Superfund.
- a. Within thirty (30) days of entry of this Consent Decree, Settling Defendants shall pay to the EPA Hazardous

Substance Superfund \$190,000.00 in reimbursement of Past Response Costs.

b. Payment shall be made by FedWire Electronic Funds

Transfer ("EFT") to the U.S. Department of Justice account in

accordance with current EFT procedures, referencing the EPA

Region and Site Spill ID Number 03-S6, and DOJ Case Number 90-11
2-1347/2, and the U.S. Attorney's Office File Number 199Z01115.

Payment shall be made in accordance with instructions provided to

Settling Defendants by the Financial Litigation Unit of the U.S.

Attorney's Office in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania

following lodging of the Consent Decree. Any payments received

by the Department of Justice after 4:00 p.m. Eastern Time shall

be credited on the next business day. Settling Defendants shall

send notice to EPA and DOJ that payment has been made in

accordance with Section XII (Notices and Submissions) and to:

EPA Regional Docket Clerk (3RC00) U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region III 1650 Arch Street Philadelphia, PA 19103.

- 5. Payment of Future Response Costs to the EPA Hazardous
 Substance Superfund.
- a. Settling Defendants shall pay to EPA all Future Response Costs not inconsistent with the National Contingency

Plan. On a periodic basis the United States will send Settling
Defendants a bill requiring payment that includes a cost summary,
setting forth direct and indirect costs incurred by EPA, DOJ, and
their contractors. Settling Defendants shall make all payments
within sixty (60) days of Settling Defendants' receipt of each
bill requiring payment, except as otherwise provided in Paragraph
6. Settling Defendants shall make all payments required by this
Paragraph by a certified or cashier's check or checks made
payable to "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund," referencing USAO
File Number 199Z01115, EPA Region III and Site Spill ID Number
03-S6, and DOJ Case Number 90-11-2-1347/2. Settling Defendants
shall send the checks to:

United States Environmental Protection Agency Region III Attention: Superfund Accounting, P.O. Box 360515, Pittsburgh, PA 125251-6515.

- b. At the time of payment, Settling Defendants shall send notice that payment has been made to EPA and DOJ in accordance with Section XII (Notices and Submissions), and to the EPA officials set forth above in Paragraph 4 (Payment of Past Response Costs).
- 6. <u>Contested Payment Procedures</u>. Settling Defendants may contest payment of any Future Response Costs under Paragraph 5 if they determine that the United States has made an accounting

error or if they allege that a cost item that is included represents costs that are inconsistent with the NCP. Such objection shall be made in writing within sixty (60) days of receipt of the bill and must be sent to the United States pursuant to Section XII (Notices and Submissions). Any such objection shall specifically identify the contested Future Response Costs and the basis for objection. In the event of an objection, the Settling Defendants shall within the sixty (60)day period pay all uncontested Future Response Costs to the United States in the manner described in Paragraph 5. Simultaneously, the Settling Defendants shall establish an interest-bearing escrow account in a federally-insured bank duly chartered in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and remit to that escrow account funds equivalent to the amount of the contested Future Response Costs. The Settling Defendants shall send to the United States, as provided in Section XII (Notices and Submissions), a copy of the transmittal letter and check paying the uncontested Future Response Costs, and a copy of the correspondence that establishes and funds the escrow account, including, but not limited to, information containing the identity of the bank and bank account under which the escrow account is established as well as a bank statement showing the

initial balance of the escrow account. Simultaneously with establishment of the escrow account, the Settling Defendants shall initiate the Dispute Resolution procedures in Section VII (Dispute Resolution). If the United States prevails in the dispute, within five (5) days of the resolution of the dispute, the Settling Defendants shall pay the sums due (with accrued interest) to the United States in the manner described in Paragraph 5. If the Settling Defendants prevail concerning any aspect of the contested costs, the Settling Defendants shall pay that portion of the costs (plus associated accrued interest) for which they did not prevail to the United States in the manner described in Paragraph 5; Settling Defendants shall be disbursed the balance of the escrow account. The dispute resolution procedures set forth in this Paragraph in conjunction with the procedures set forth in Section VII (Dispute Resolution) shall be the exclusive mechanisms for resolving disputes regarding the Settling Defendants' obligation to reimburse the United States for its Future Response Costs.

7. Interest on Late Payments. In the event that the payments required by Subparagraph 4.a are not made within thirty (30) days of the Effective Date as defined in Section XVI herein or the payments required by Paragraph 5 are not made within sixty

(60) days of the Settling Defendants' receipt of the bill,
Settling Defendants shall pay Interest on the unpaid balance.
The Interest to be paid on Past Response Costs under this
Paragraph shall begin to accrue on the Effective Date as defined
in Section XVI herein. The Interest on Future Response Costs
shall begin to accrue on the date of the bill. The Interest
shall accrue through the date of the Settling Defendants'
payment. Payments of Interest made under this Paragraph shall be
in addition to such other remedies or sanctions available to
Plaintiff by virtue of Settling Defendants' failure to make
timely payments under this Section including, but not limited to,
payment of stipulated penalties pursuant to Paragraph 8. The
Settling Defendants shall make all payments required by this
Paragraph in the manner described in Paragraph 5.

VI. STIPULATED PENALTIES

8. Stipulated Penalties.

a. If any amounts due to EPA under this Consent Decree are not paid by the required date, Settling Defendants shall pay to EPA as a stipulated penalty, in addition to the Interest required by Paragraph 7, \$500.00 per violation per day for each of the first fourteen (14) days that such payment is late, and \$1,000.00 per day for each day that such payment is late

thereafter.

b. Stipulated penalties are due and payable within thirty (30) days of the date of the demand for payment of the penalties by EPA, unless Settling Defendants invoke the Dispute Resolution procedures under Section VII, in which case payment shall be stayed in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 16. All payments to EPA under this Paragraph shall be made by certified or cashier's check made payable to "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund" and shall be sent to:

United States Environmental Protection Agency Region III Attention: Superfund Accounting, P.O. Box 360515, Pittsburgh, PA 125251-6515.

All payments shall indicate that the payment is for stipulated penalties and shall reference the name and address of the party making payment, the name of the Site, EPA Region III and Site Spill ID Number 03-S6, and DOJ Case Number 90-11-2-1347/2. Copies of checks paid pursuant to this Paragraph, and any accompanying transmittal letters, shall be sent to EPA and DOJ as provided in Section XII (Notices and Submissions) and to:

EPA Regional Docket Clerk (3RC00) U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region III 1650 Arch Street Philadelphia, PA 19103.

- c. Stipulated penalties shall accrue as provided in this Paragraph 8 regardless of whether EPA has notified Settling Defendants of the violation or made a demand for payment, but need only be paid upon demand. All penalties shall begin to accrue on the day after complete performance is due or the day a violation occurs, and shall continue to accrue through the final day of correction of the noncompliance or completion of the activity. Nothing herein shall prevent the simultaneous accrual of separate penalties for separate violations of this Consent Decree.
- d. Penalties shall continue to accrue as provided in Subparagraph 8.c during any dispute resolution period, but need not be paid until the following:
- 1. If the dispute is resolved by agreement or by a decision of EPA that is not appealed to this Court, accrued penalties determined to be owing shall be paid to EPA within thirty (30) days of the agreement or the receipt of EPA's decision;
- 2. If the dispute is appealed to this Court and the United States prevails in whole or in part, Settling

 Defendants shall pay all accrued penalties determined by the

 Court to be owed to EPA within sixty (60) days of receipt of the

Court's decision or order, except as provided in Subparagraph 3 below;

- 3. If the District Court's decision is appealed by any Party, Settling Defendants shall pay all accrued penalties determined by the District Court to be owing to the United States into an interest-bearing escrow account within sixty (60) days of receipt of the Court's decision or order. Penalties shall be paid into this account as they continue to accrue, at least every sixty (60) days. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of the final appellate court decision, the escrow agent shall pay the balance of the account to EPA or to Settling Defendants to the extent that they prevail.
- 9. If the United States brings an action to enforce this Consent Decree against Settling Defendants, Settling Defendants shall reimburse the United States for all costs of such action, including but not limited to costs of attorney time.
- 10. Payments made under Paragraphs 4, 5 and 8 above by Settling Defendants shall be in addition to any other remedies or sanctions available to Plaintiff by virtue of Settling Defendants' failure to comply with the requirements of this Consent Decree.

- 11. The obligations of the Settling Defendants to pay amounts owed the United States under this Consent Decree are joint and several. In the event of the failure of any one or more Settling Defendants to contribute to the payments required under this Consent Decree, the remaining Settling Defendants shall be responsible for such payments.
- 12. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Section, the United States may, in its unreviewable discretion, waive payment of any portion of the stipulated penalties that have accrued pursuant to this Consent Decree.

VII. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 13. Unless otherwise expressly provided for in this Consent Decree, the dispute resolution procedures of this Section shall be the exclusive mechanism to resolve disputes arising under or with respect to this Consent Decree. However, the procedures set forth in this Section VII shall not apply to actions by the United States to enforce obligations of the Settling Defendants that have not been disputed in accordance with this Section VII.
- 14. <u>Informal Dispute Resolution</u>. Any dispute which arises under or with respect to this Consent Decree shall in the first instance be the subject of informal negotiations between the parties to the dispute. The period for informal negotiations

shall not exceed twenty (20) days from the time the dispute arises, unless it is modified by written agreement of the parties to the dispute. The dispute shall be considered to have arisen when one Party sends the other Party a written Notice of Dispute.

15. Formal Dispute Resolution.

- a. In the event that the Parties cannot resolve a dispute by informal negotiations under the preceding Paragraph 14, then the position advanced by EPA shall be considered binding unless, within twenty-one (21) days after the conclusion of the informal negotiation period, Settling Defendants invoke the formal dispute resolution procedures of this Section VII by serving on the United States a written Statement of Position on the matter in dispute, including, but not limited to, any factual data, analysis or opinion supporting that position and any supporting documentation relied upon by Settling Defendants.
- b. Within thirty (30) days after receipt of Settling
 Defendants' Statement of Position, EPA will serve on Settling
 Defendants its Statement of Position, including, but not limited
 to, any factual data, analysis, or opinion supporting that
 position and all supporting documentation relied upon by EPA.
 Within fifteen (15) days after receipt of EPA's Statement of
 Position, Settling Defendants may submit a Reply.

- c. Following receipt of the Parties' Statements of Position, the Director of the Hazardous Site Cleanup Division, EPA Region III, will issue a final decision resolving the dispute. The Director's decision shall be binding on the Settling Defendants unless, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the decision, the Settling Defendants file with the Court and serve on the United States a motion for judicial review of the decision setting forth the matter in dispute, the efforts made by the Parties to resolve it, the relief requested, and the schedule, if any, within which the dispute must be resolved to ensure orderly implementation of the Consent Decree. The United States may file a response to Settling Defendants' motion. Judicial review of any dispute governed by this Paragraph 15 shall be governed by applicable principles of law.
- 16. The invocation of formal dispute resolution procedures under this Section VII shall not extend, postpone, or affect in any way any obligation of the Settling Defendants under this Consent Decree unless EPA or the Court agrees otherwise. Stipulated penalties with respect to the disputed matter shall continue to accrue but payment shall be stayed pending resolution of the dispute. Notwithstanding the stay of payment, stipulated penalties shall accrue from the first day of noncompliance with

any applicable provision of this Consent Decree. In the event that Settling Defendants do not prevail on the disputed issue, stipulated penalties shall be assessed and paid as provided in Section VI (Stipulated Penalties).

VIII. COVENANT NOT TO SUE BY PLAINTIFF

17. Covenant Not to Sue by United States.

Except as specifically provided in Paragraph 18 (Reservation of Rights by United States), the United States covenants not to sue Settling Defendants pursuant to Section 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a), to recover Past Response Costs and Future Response Costs as defined in this Consent Decree. These covenants not to sue shall take effect upon receipt by EPA of all payments to the EPA Hazardous Substances Superfund required by Section V, Paragraphs 4 (Payment of Past Response Costs) and 5 (Payment of Future Response Costs), and all payments required by Section V, Paragraph 6 (Interest on Late Payments) and Section VI (Stipulated Penalties). These covenants not to sue are conditioned upon the satisfactory performance by Settling Defendants of all of their obligations under this Consent Decree. These covenants not to sue extend only to Settling Defendants and do not extend to any other person.

- 18. Reservation of Rights by United States. The covenants not to sue set forth in Paragraph 17 do not pertain to any matters other than those expressly specified therein. The United States reserves, and this Consent Decree is without prejudice to, all rights against Settling Defendants with respect to all other matters, including but not limited to:
- a. liability of Settling Defendants for failure to meet a requirement of this Consent Decree;
- b. liability for damages for injury to, destruction of, or loss of natural resources, and for the costs of any natural resource damage assessments;
 - c. criminal liability;
- d. liability for injunctive relief or administrative order enforcement under Section 106 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9606;
- e. liability for response costs incurred or to be incurred by the United States that are not within the definitions of Past Response Costs or Future Response Costs; and
- f. liability for Future Response Costs not yet reimbursed pursuant to Section V.

IX. COVENANT NOT TO SUE BY SETTLING DEFENDANTS

19. Settling Defendants covenant not to sue and agree not to assert any claims or causes of action against the United

States, or its contractors or employees, with respect to the Site or this Consent Decree, including but not limited to:

- a. any direct or indirect claim for reimbursement from the Hazardous Substance Superfund based on Sections 106(b)(2), 107, 111, 112, or 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(b)(2), 9607, 9611, 9612, or 9613, or any other provision of law;
- b. any claim arising out of response actions at the
 Site; and
- c. any claim against the United States pursuant to Sections 107 and 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607 and 9613, relating to the Site.
- 20. Nothing in this Consent Decree shall be deemed to constitute approval or preauthorization of a claim within the meaning of Section 111 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9611, or 40 C.F.R. § 300.700(d).
- 21. Waiver of Claims Against De Micromis Parties. Settling Defendants agree not to assert any claims and to waive all claims or causes of action that they may have for all matters relating to the Site, including for contribution, against any person where the person's liability to Settling Defendants with respect to the Site is based solely on having arranged for disposal or treatment, or for transport for disposal or treatment, of

hazardous substances at the Site, or having accepted for transport for disposal or treatment of hazardous substances at the Site, if any materials contributed by such person to the Site did not exceed 110 gallons of liquid materials or 200 pounds of solid materials. This waiver shall not apply to any claim or cause of action against any person meeting the above criteria if EPA has determined that the materials contributed to the Site by such person contributed or could contribute significantly to the costs of response at the Site. This waiver also shall not apply with respect to any defense, claim, or cause of action that a Settling Defendant may have against any person if such person asserts a claim or cause of action relating to the Site against any Settling Defendant. This waiver also shall not apply to any claim or cause of action against any person meeting the above de micromis exemption criteria if:

a. EPA determines, as provided in Section 107(o)(2)(A)(i) and (ii) of CERCLA, that the materials containing hazardous substances contributed to the Site by such person have contributed significantly, or could contribute significantly, either individually or in the aggregate, to the cost of response action or natural resource restoration at the Site; or that such person has failed to comply with any EPA request for information

or administrative subpoenas issued pursuant to Section 104(e) or 122(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9604(e) or 9622(e), or has impeded or is impeding, through action or inaction, the performance of a response action or natural resource restoration with respect to the Site.

- b. as provided in Section 107(o)(2)(B) of CERCLA, such person has been convicted of a criminal violation for the conduct to which the de micromis exemption would apply and that conviction has not been vitiated on appeal or otherwise.
- 22. Waiver of Claims Against Municipal Solid Waste Parties.

 Settling Defendants agree not to assert any claim and to waive all claims or causes of action that they may have for all matters relating to the Site, including for contribution, against any person where the person's liability to Settling Defendants with respect to the Site is based solely on having arranged for disposal or treatment, or for transport for disposal or treatment, of Municipal Solid Waste ("MSW"), as defined herein, at the Site, if the volume of MSW disposed, treated or transported by such person to the Site did not exceed 0.2 percent of the total volume of waste at the Site. This waiver shall not apply with respect to any defense, claim, or cause of action that a Settling Defendant may have against any person meeting the

above criterion if such person asserts a claim or cause of action relating to the Site against such Settling Defendant. This waiver also shall not apply to any claim or cause of action against any person meeting the above criteria if EPA determines, as provided in Section 107(p)(2) of CERCLA, that: (a) the MSW contributed significantly or could contribute significantly, either individually or in the aggregate, to the cost of the response action or natural resource restoration at the Site; (b) the person has failed to comply with any information request or administrative subpoena issued pursuant to Section 104(e) or 122(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9604(e) or § 9622(e); or (c) the person impeded or is impeding, through action or inaction, the performance of a response action or natural resource restoration with respect to the Site.

23. Waiver of Claims Against Settled De Minimis Parties.

Settling Defendants agree not to assert any claims and to waive all claims or causes of action that they may have for all matters relating to the Site, including for contribution, against those parties whose liability to the United States with respect to the Site was resolved through Partial Consent Decrees entered on July 14, 2000 and August 17, 2000 by United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania in the matter of United

States v. Fleetwood Industries, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 00-1818 (E.D. Pa). This waiver shall not apply with respect to any defense, claim or cause of action that any Settling Defendant may have against any person if such person asserts a claim or cause of action relating to the Site against such Settling Defendant.

X. EFFECT OF SETTLEMENT/CONTRIBUTION PROTECTION

24. Except as provided in Paragraph 21 (Waiver of Claims Against De Micromis Parties), Paragraph 22 (Waiver of Claims Against Municipal Solid Waste Parties) and Paragraph 23 (Waiver of Claims Against Settled De Minimis Parties), nothing in this Consent Decree shall be construed to create any rights in, or grant any cause of action to, any person not a Party to this Consent Decree. Except as provided in Paragraph 21 (Waiver of Claims Against De Micromis Parties), Paragraph 22 (Waiver of Claims Against Municipal Solid Waste Parties) and Paragraph 23 (Waiver of Claims Against Settled De Minimis Parties), each of the Parties expressly reserves any and all rights (including, but not limited to, any right to contribution), defenses, claims, demands, and causes of action which each Party may have with respect to any matter, transaction, or occurrence relating in any way to the Site against any person not a Party hereto.

- 25. The Parties agree, and by entering this Consent Decree this Court finds, that Settling Defendants are entitled, as of the Effective Date of this Consent Decree, to protection from contribution actions or claims as provided by Section 113(f)(2) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9613(f)(2), for "matters addressed" in this Consent Decree. The "matters addressed" in this Consent Decree are Past Response Costs and Future Response Costs reimbursed by Settling Defendants pursuant to this Consent Decree.
- 26. Settling Defendants agree that they will notify EPA and DOJ in writing no later than sixty (60) days prior to the initiation of any suit or claim for contribution brought by any Settling Defendant for matters related to this Consent Decree, except any such suit or claim which Settling Defendants initiated prior to lodging of this Consent Decree. Settling Defendants also agree that, with respect to any suit or claim for contribution brought against any Settling Defendant for matters related to this Consent Decree, they will notify EPA and DOJ in writing within ten (10) days of service of the complaint or claim upon it. In addition, Settling Defendants shall notify EPA and DOJ within ten (10) days of service or receipt of any Motion for Summary Judgment, and within ten (10) days of receipt of any

order from a court setting a case for trial, for matters related to this Consent Decree.

27. In any subsequent administrative or judicial proceeding initiated by the United States for injunctive relief, recovery of response costs, or other relief relating to the Site, Settling Defendants shall not assert, and may not maintain, any defense or claim based upon the principles of waiver, res judicata, collateral estoppel, issue preclusion, claim-splitting, or other defenses based upon any contention that the claims raised by the United States in the subsequent proceeding were or should have been brought in the instant case; provided, however, that nothing in this Paragraph affects the enforceability of the Covenant Not to Sue by Plaintiff set forth in Section VIII.

XI. ACCESS TO INFORMATION

28. Settling Defendants shall provide to EPA, upon request, copies of all documents and information within their possession or control or that of their contractors or agents relating to activities at the Site, including, but not limited to, sampling, analysis, chain of custody records, manifests, trucking logs, receipts, reports, sample traffic routing, correspondence, or other documents or information related to the Site.

- 29. <u>Confidential Business Information and Privileged</u>
 Documents.
- a. Any Settling Defendant may assert business confidentiality claims covering part or all of the documents or information submitted to Plaintiff under this Consent Decree to the extent permitted by and in accordance with Section 104(e)(7) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9604(e)(7), and 40 C.F.R. § 2.203(b). Documents or information determined to be confidential by EPA will be accorded the protection specified in 40 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart B. If no claim of confidentiality accompanies documents or information when they are submitted to EPA, or if EPA has notified the Settling Defendant that the documents or information are not confidential under the standards of Section 104(e)(7) of CERCLA, the public may be given access to such documents or information without further notice to the Settling Defendant.
- b. Any Settling Defendant may assert that certain documents, records or other information are privileged under the attorney-client privilege or any other privilege recognized by federal law. If a Settling Defendant asserts such a privilege in lieu of providing documents, it shall provide Plaintiff with the following: 1) the title of the document, record, or information; 2) the date of the document, record, or information; 3) the name

and title of the author of the document, record, or information;

4) the name and title of each addressee and recipient; 5) a

description of the subject of the document, record, or

information; and 6) the privilege asserted. However, no

documents, reports or other information created or generated

pursuant to the requirements of this or any other Consent Decree

with the United States shall be withheld on the grounds that they

are privileged. If a claim of privilege applies only to a

portion of a document, the document shall be provided to

Plaintiff in redacted form to mask the privileged information

only. The relevant Settling Defendant shall retain all records

and documents that it claims to be privileged until the United

States has had a reasonable opportunity to dispute the privilege

claim and any such dispute has been resolved in the Settling

Defendant's favor.

- 30. No claim of confidentiality shall be made with respect to any data, including but not limited to, all sampling, analytical, monitoring, hydrogeologic, scientific, chemical, or engineering data, or any other documents or information evidencing conditions at or around the Site.
- 31. By signing this Consent Decree, each Settling Defendant certifies that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, it has

fully complied with any and all EPA requests for information regarding the Site pursuant to Sections 104(e) and 122(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9604(e) and 9622(e).

XII. NOTICES AND SUBMISSIONS

32. Whenever, under the terms of this Consent Decree, notice is required to be given or a document is required to be sent by one party to another, it shall be directed to the individuals at the addresses specified below, unless those individuals or their successors give notice of a change to the other Parties in writing. Written notice as specified herein shall constitute complete satisfaction of any written notice requirement of the Consent Decree with respect to the United States, EPA, DOJ, and Settling Defendants, respectively.

XIII. RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

33. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of interpreting and enforcing the terms of this Consent Decree.

XIV. INTEGRATION/APPENDICES

34. This Consent Decree and its Appendices constitute the final, complete and exclusive agreement and understanding among the Parties with respect to the settlement embodied in this Consent Decree. The Parties acknowledge that there are no representations, agreements or understandings relating to the settlement other than those expressly contained in this Consent Decree. The following Appendices are attached to and incorporated into this Consent Decree: "Appendix A" is the complete list of Settling Defendants; and "Appendix B" is the map of the Site.

XV. LODGING AND OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

35. This Consent Decree shall be lodged with the Court for a period of not less than thirty (30) days for public notice and

comment. The United States reserves the right to withdraw or withhold its consent if the comments regarding the Consent Decree disclose facts or considerations which indicate that this Consent Decree is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate. Settling Defendants consent to the entry of this Consent Decree without further notice.

36. If for any reason this Court should decline to approve this Consent Decree in the form presented, this agreement is voidable at the sole discretion of any Party and the terms of the agreement may not be used as evidence in any litigation between the Parties.

XVI. EFFECTIVE DATE

37. The effective date of this Consent Decree shall be the date upon which it is entered by the Court.

XVII. SIGNATORIES/SERVICE

38. Each undersigned representative of a Settling Defendant to this Consent Decree and of the Assistant Attorney General for the Environment and Natural Resources Division of the United States Department of Justice certifies that he or she is authorized to enter into the terms and conditions of this Consent Decree and to execute and bind legally such Party to this document.

- 39. Each Settling Defendant hereby agrees not to oppose entry of this Consent Decree by this Court or to challenge any provision of this Consent Decree, unless the United States has notified Settling Defendants in writing that it no longer supports entry of the Consent Decree.
- 40. Each Settling Defendant shall identify, on the attached signature page, the name and address of an agent who is authorized to accept service of process by mail on behalf of that Party with respect to all matters arising under or relating to this Consent Decree. Each Settling Defendant hereby agrees, if necessary, to accept service in that manner and to waive the formal service requirements set forth in Rule 4 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and any applicable local rules of this Court, including but not limited to, service of a summons.

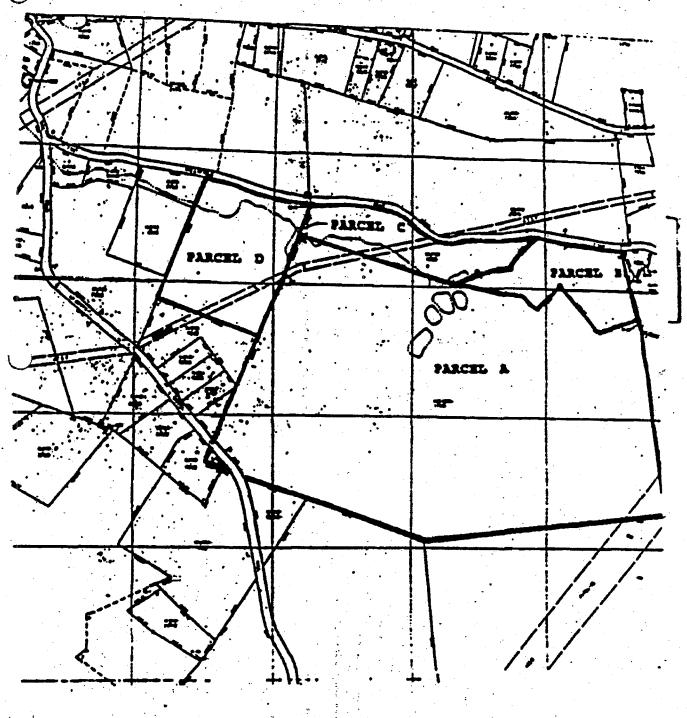
